


The UK construction industry could save up to £25 billion a year by avoiding error

The Get It Right Initiative is dedicated to making this happen.

Studies suggest the direct cost of avoidable error across the construction industry is around 5% of project value – well above average profit levels in the sector and costing approximately £5 billion per annum.

Unmeasured and indirect costs bring estimates closer to 10-25% of project cost, or up to £25 billion each year in the UK.
